HISTORY OF PIEF

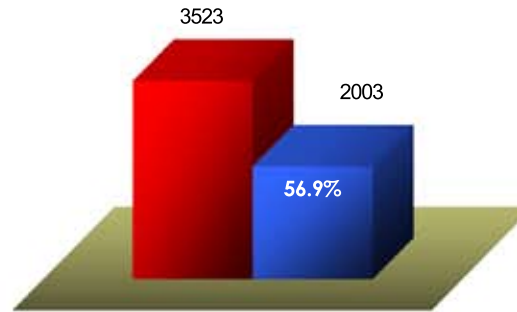
The Pearl and Ivy Educational Foundation, Inc. (PIEF) was established in 1988 by members of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, Xi Omega Chapter in Washington, D.C. Members are dedicated volunteers, committed to serving those in our community who are in need.

Since its inception, a continuing focus of the Foundation has been to support opportunities for deserving youth graduating from the public high and public charter schools in Washington, D.C. to attend college and continue graduate school education. In November 2015, PIEF created the Pearl and Ivy Educational Foundation Scholarship Endowment Fund (PIEF-SEF) so that interested donors can contribute to an interest bearing account.

The interest on the principal will generate income to fund a scholarship in the name of the donor or the name designated by the donor annually in perpetuity once the investment goal is reached. The first endowed scholarship is scheduled to be awarded in 2023 when the Xi Omega Chapter celebrates its Centennial Anniversary.

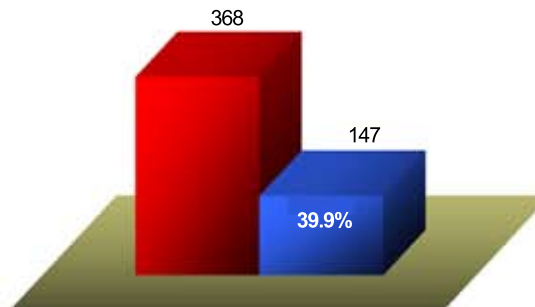

How It Works

- Complete a new fund agreement with PIEF
- Select an unrestricted (no specifications) \$5,000 scholarship or restricted \$10,000 (specify institution or course of study)
- Make a one time payment or schedule a payment plan
- Specify a bequest

PIEF will oversee the application process and select recipients based upon the criteria established, if restricted.
